To protect children's lives now and in the future through foreign, humanitarian and development policy:

- Prioritise funding for **health**, **nutrition**, **and education** services and return to spending 0.7% of GNI on official development assistance.
- Protect children, their rights and the services they need from the climate crisis.
- Protect children from the impacts of humanitarian emergencies.

STORY

- Ensure every baby and toddler can access their right to affordable, quality early education and childcare in their local area.
- **Tackle child poverty** and provide financial support that works for all parents of babies and toddlers when they need it.
- Ensure all parents of babies and toddlers can access quality mental health support.

- Deliver a rights-based approach in schools, hospitals and communities across the UK.
